1. 2'9" Equitation Over Fences
2. 2'6" Equitation Over Fences
3. 2'3" Equitation Over Fences
4. 2' Equitation Over Fences
5. 18" Equitation Over Fences
6. 12" Trot-A-Course Over Fences
7. Trot-A-Pole Over Fences

8. 2'9" Medal
9. 2'6" Medal (same height as OHJA Mini Medal)
10. 2'3" Medal (same height as Nancy Wild Medal)
11. 2' Medal

**No class results will count toward USHJA or OHJA awards.*

How it Works:

- **LOEC will provide the courses for each class.** There will be one course for Equitation, and one for Medal (along with a jump off). We will also provide a video demonstration of the courses being ridden by as well as some rider tips from course designer! Riders will set the courses according to our specifications for each class, including heights, distances, etc.
- Riders will have video taken from a designated spot on course. Everyone will video from the same spot, so the judge has the same perspective for each entry.
- The Show will be posted and pinned on our facebook account (LO Equestrian), where you will find a photo containing each class name (ie "1. 2'9" Equitation Over Fences").
** No facebook account? No problem! You can email your video to the show manager, who can post it for you.
- You will post your video in the comments section under the class name/number that matches the class you are entering. Then, you will comment/reply to your video with the name of the rider and horse.
- Our judge, Anna Linde, will view each video, and then place the class.
- Ribbons and awards will be mailed to the address you provide!

SPECIFICATIONS:

- **Videos may be uploaded to the LO Equestrian facebook page between June 18 and June 27. Videos must be submitted NO LATER than 8pm on Saturday June 27 to be eligible.**

- Braiding and show attire are not required, but are encouraged!
- Courses must contain verticals only (no oxers, etc.)
- Entries are welcome to decorate their jumps as they would like (flower boxes, etc.), as long as the course and jump heights follow LOEC specifications


